

Yukon: The 366-feet, retired Canadian Mackenzie Class Destroyer was set to be intentionally sunk on July 15th 2000, but the night before the big ceremony, she filled with seawater and sank to the seafloor 100-feet below. Yukon now rests on her port side with a minimum depth of about 65-feet along her starboard side.

Ruby E: Is a 165-foot long USCG Cutter, she was intentionally reefed on June 18, 1989 in approx. 80-feet of water. Ruby E sits upright in the sand with nearly every inch of her covered in sea life.
